WorkSite Mobility on the iPhone delivers seamless integration with Apple's popular mobile device and provides users with powerful, easy and secure access to information in WorkSite repositories. Being a native iPhone application and leveraging ground-breaking technology in the iPhone provides multiple advantages for document viewing, including the built-in high-fidelity viewers, multi-touch zooming, document rotation, and more -- all over iPhone's fast WiFi and 3G networking capabilities. The integration allows WorkSite users to effectively access and manage their email and engagement-related content from anywhere and enables them to stay productive and responsive to client needs.

WorkSite Mobility on the BlackBerry enables users to access client files, view documents, file email, create new email, and attach documents and links even when there is no signal, so users can continue working even when on a plane.
